During '80s Paweł was an academic lecturer at the Warsaw Technical University (Politechnika Warszawska) in the Institute for Social and Economic Sciences. He then worked as a visiting attorney for a New York law firm Willkie Farr & Gallagher (1990-92). In years 1992-93 he was an Assistant Director at Barclays de Zoete Wedd in Warsaw. Next, he was appointed a role with the Polish Ministry of State Treasury, where he was the General Counsel for the Mass Privatisation Programme (1993-95). Later on, Paweł became President of the Management Board of Investment Fund Services Company Ltd. (OFI Sp. z o.o.), a mutual fund administrator and transfer agent, a joint venture between Bank Handlowy and a U.S mutual fund services company - Forum Financial Group, Inc. In 1996-1999 he was President of Daiwa Europe Polska, the Polish branch of Japanese investment bank, Daiwa Securities (1996-99). From 1999 through 2009 he worked for Morgan Stanley as the Senior Advisor, representing the bank in Poland.
